Does "Walk-in" mean I'll be seen right away?

The wait times will depend on the volume of patients at any given time. Since no appointments are made, those volumes will be subject to some variation.

What is the Walk-In Clinic?

The Walk-In Clinic is designed to be a convenient alternative when you cannot get a same-day appointment with your own provider for an urgent health care need.

TIMES:

Monday—Thursday 3pm-5pm
Friday 2pm- 4pm

Will I see my provider?

You will be seen by the designated provider of the day since there are no specific appointment times.

Can I still make an appointment for these types of an appointment?

Yes, we would prefer that you do. You will have shorter wait times, and a set time to see your provider. If you would prefer to schedule a specific appointment time with your provider about an acute medical concern, please call 215-440-8681 to schedule.

What about more complicated problems that need urgent attention?

There are certain more complicated conditions that walk-in hours will not be able to handle—we reserve the right to refuse care during these hours and will recommend to patients to schedule an appointment for issues not listed above.
